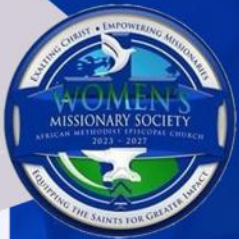

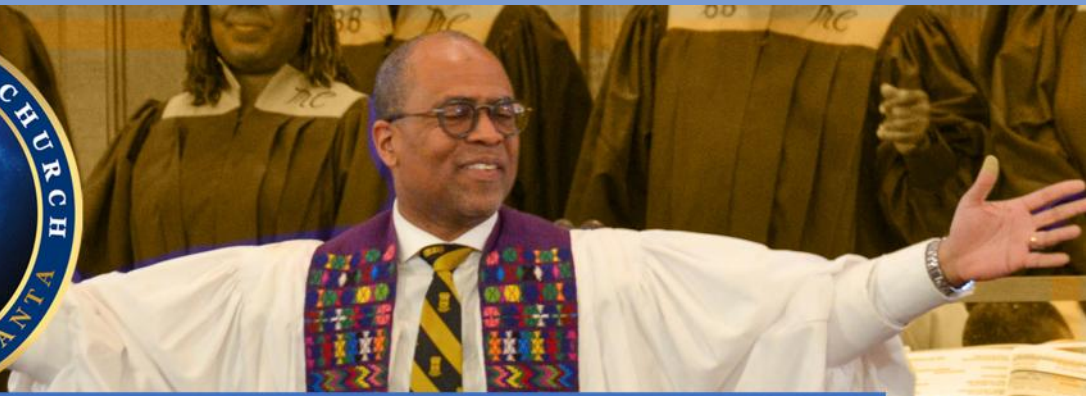

For twenty-eight years, she has been a pillar of support for her husband, Bishop Julius H. 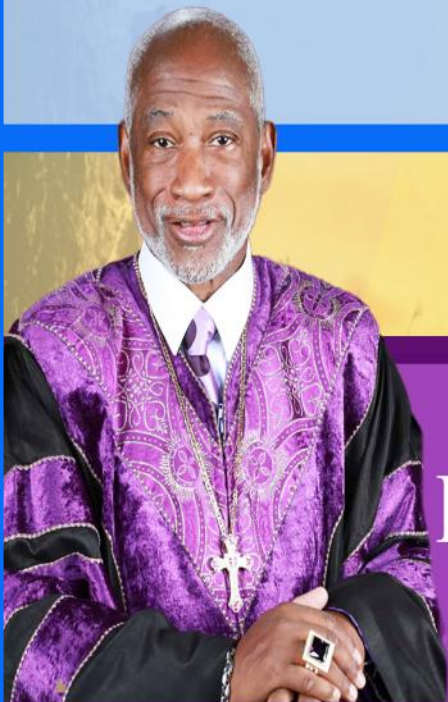

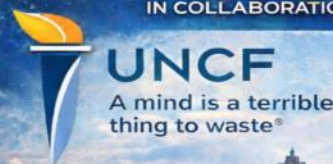
